The Government of Montenegro has received a loan in the amount of EUR 6 million from the International Bank for Reconstruction Development (IBRD) toward the cost of the Second Energy Efficiency Project-MEEP 2, and intends to apply part of the proceeds to the payments for the Construction Craft “**Works on General Hospital Nikšić and Health center Podgorica-Konik**”.

The Ministry of Energy and Mining and Ministry of Health, through the Technical Service Unit-TSU, invites sealed bids for the construction craft works which will include construction-craft works, electrical and mechanical installation works, joinery replacement, heating insulation and other renovation measures, **General Hospital Nikšić**: Main building, Psychiatry building, Pediatrics building and **Health center Podgorica-Konik**.

Implementation of measures which have an effect to improve and increase the “ENERGY EFFICIENCY” on existing health facilities situated in: **Nikšić and Podgorica**. The projected term for realization is **180 days** in total.

Bidding process will be conducted through the **Request for Bids-National market approach**, procedures as specified in the World Bank’s *Procurement Regulations for Investment Project Financing (IPF) Borrowers’*, issued in July 2016 revised November 2017 and August 2018, and it is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 3.14 setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

A complete set of bidding documents (SBD) in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders, and will be sent by email to interested bidders, upon the submission of a written application and proof of payment of a non-refundable fee of 100,00EUR on the account **832-1191-19**, to the email address below. Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same e-mail address.

Prior to contract signing successful Bidder is obliged to provide necessary licenses for works performing, (as defined in the bidding document) and in accordance with the Law on Spatial Planning and Construction of Structures (Official Gazette of Montenegro No. 064/17, 044/18, 063/18, 11/2019 and 82/2020). All bids must be accompanied by a **Bid Security declaration**.

Pre Bid conference for all interested and eligible bidders, will be organized upon request.

Bids **Ref. No: MNE-MEEP2-8870-ME-RFBN-W-23-1.1.6.** must be delivered to the address below, on or before **January 09, 2024, 10:00h.** Electronic bidding *will not* be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below **January 09, 2024, 10:05h.**
