The Government of Montenegro has received a loan in the amount of EUR 6 million from the International Bank for Reconstruction Development (IBRD) toward the cost of the Second Energy Efficiency Project-MEEP 2, and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the Construction Craft **Works on PHI Health Center Bar and PHI Health Center Herceg Novi.**

The Ministry of Energy and Mining and the Ministry of Health, through the Technical Service Unit-TSU, invites sealed bids for the construction craft works which will include: thermal insulation of the roof with EPS, partial replacement of the external joinery with a new PVC joinery with double glazing, automatic regulation of the hot water boiler, installation of TR valve, replacement of existing lighting fixtures with new ones in LED technology and other renovation measures on existing two (2) Public Health facilities situated in: Bar and Herceg Novi.

The projected term for realization and implementation of measures which have an effect to improve and increase the **"ENERGY EFFICIENCY"** on existing facilities is **210 days** in total.

Bidding process will be conducted through the **Request for Bids-National market approach**, procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Procurement Regulations for Investment Project Financing (IPF) Borrowers', issued in July 2016 revised November 2017 and August 2018*, and it is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 3.14 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

*Prior to contract signing successful Bidder is obliged to provide necessary licenses for works performing, (as defined in the bidding document) and in accordance with the Law on Spatial

Planning and Construction of Structures (Official Gazette of Montenegro 64/17, 44/18, 63/18 from 28.09.2018). All bids must be accompanied by a *Bid Security declaration*.
